 Take U.S. 127 south to the first St. Johns exit. Turn right and follow Business 127/Old 27 for approximately 2 miles. CCRESA is located in St. Johns on Business 127/Old 27 in the Southpoint Mall (McDonald's is directly across the road).

Directions From the South:
 Take U.S. 127 north from Lansing to the Price Rd. exit. Turn left to travel west on Price Rd. to the light (which is Business 127/Old 27).
